EXPERIENCE

Phil McGrane is running as a Republican candidate for Idaho Secretary of State. McGrane's career in elections began in 2005 counting punch cards and recruiting poll workers. Since then he has served as a law clerk to the United States Elections Assistance Commission and has been involved in every aspect of running elections in Ada County.

As chair of the Elections Committee for the Idaho Association of County Recorders and Clerks, McGrane created and organized the first-of-its-kind statewide elections conference to provide common training for all election officials across the state. During the tumultuous 2020 election, McGrane organized county clerks across the state to successfully lobby for a special legislative session. Legislation from that

session provided county clerks across Idaho additional time to process the unprecedented volume of absentee ballots, ensuring Idaho results were available on election night.

As the elected Ada County Clerk McGrane manages a team of 198 clerks in Elections, Courts, Budget & Finance, Property Records, and Indigent Medical Assistance. As the chief budget officer for the county, he oversees a \$295 million budget. He supervises elections for nearly 300,000 registered voters over 197 precincts.
